- Look up your **AASU student ID #** (<http://ship.armstrong.edu/>). The first time you log in your password will be your birthday – MMDDYY.
- Log on to **Pirates Cove** and set up your AASU email account. Click here for instructions. (new link)
 - From Pirates Cove you can get to S.H.I.P. (yes, we are the AASU *Pirates*) where you can check on your financial aid, register for classes, see your grades and pay on-line.
- Check **financial aid** status for new requirements
 - This is REALLY important. To avoid delays in your aid make sure you have everything in early.
