

**2010 Armstrong Atlantic State University
Homecoming King and Queen Application**

The Campus Union Board and Student Government Association are sponsoring the 2010 Armstrong Atlantic State University Homecoming Court. The Homecoming Court will be part of the Homecoming Week activities taking place February 22-27, 2010.

Only juniors and seniors according to earned credit hours (60+) are eligible to apply to be the AASU Homecoming King and Queen. Applicants must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5.

All applicants must be sponsored by an academic department or recognized student organization. Departments and organizations may sponsor only one King and/or one Queen. The Application **deadline will be Friday, February 5, 2010**. Please turn your application into the Student Activities office located in MCC room 201.

Homecoming King and Queen Selection Process:

All applications are screened by a Homecoming Court Selection Committee made up of three students, one faculty and one staff member. Once all participants are reviewed, ten applicants (five King and five Queen) are invited to continue the process (interview and popular vote) as a member of the Homecoming Court. The application and interview selection process are based upon Armstrong involvement, community involvement, academics and leadership qualities. Student body votes count for sixty percent of the selection. Voting will take place the week of Homecoming. Interviews will take place at the scheduled times below and count for the other forty percent. All applicants are encouraged to attend all Homecoming events and are at minimum required to attend the Homecoming Kickoff Feb 22nd at 8pm (Alumni Arena) and the Men's Basketball game Feb. 27th at 7:30pm (Alumni Arena).
