Beginning in the Fall, 2003, students will not have independent research projects or theses but will be working on research projects that are part of faculty ongoing research activities.

Description: Introduction to the politics of environmental issues from local, national, and international perspectives including public perception, competing ideologies, the nature of the political process, the courts, the media, and political institutions.

Rationale: To provide students with an historical overview of the development and changes in environmental policy from several levels of analysis: local, national, and international perspectives. It also increases our selection of courses in the comparative politics area.
