MHSA 8625 Health Informatics 3-0-3
Prerequisites: None
Description: A study of the disciplinary field that deals with the storage, retrieval, sharing and optimal use of health-related information, data, and knowledge for problem solving and decision making in a variety of organizational settings.

Rationale: This course, which had previously existed as a required course in the MHSA program, had inexplicably been deleted from the catalog listing of courses. This course is being added back to address accreditation issues related to curricular content for both the MHSA and MPH programs.
