SUBJECT: Graduate Faculty Meeting

The Graduate Faculty met on Monday, November 26, 2007 at 12:10 p.m. in Science Center Room 1402. Dr. Ellen Whitford, Vice President and Dean of Faculty, presided. I. The minutes from the meeting of April 24, 2007 were approved as presented.

II. Reports of Standing Committees:

A. Graduate Council – Michael Price

The Council met three times Fall Semester with the next meeting scheduled for December 11, 2007. This semester we discussed procedure for the integration of the Graduate Council into the Senate.

B. Graduate Curriculum Committee – Michael Price

The committee met three times during the semester. The committee approved 6 new courses, to include Cyber Security cross-listed as both Criminal Justice and Information Technology, designed to respond to the critical need for information security.

C. Graduate Faculty Status and Activities Committee – Carol Jamison

The committee met three times this semester and approved 32 applications for Graduate Faculty Status. These included 7 full, 5 associate, 12 assistant, 8 adjunct.

Questions were raised in regard to the method of approving faculty for renewal of status. Dr. Price stated that any suggestions for a change in this method can be proposed to the new

subcommittee that will be formed as part of the faculty senate. The senate subcommittee will revisit all requirements for graduate faculty status review.

D. Graduate Academic Policy and Student Affairs Committee – John Kraft

There was no activity to report regarding academic policy. Dr. Kraft announced the upcoming edition of Who's Who Among Students in American Universities and Colleges and solicited nominees from graduate faculty. He added that each department can establish criteria and method for nominating students.

E. Graduate Student Appeals Committee - Teresa Winterhalter
