

Interdisciplinary Committee Minutes

Members present: Teresa Winterhalter, Joshua Smith, William Daugherty and Priya Goeser

Minutes: The committee reviewed and accepted the proposal for the European Union Studies Courses. The committee has recommended the proposal be sent to the University Curriculum Committee.

The committee recommends that if a course has an application to an interdisciplinary program within one of the colleges, then the interdisciplinary committee should review the proposed course before it enters the standard curricular review process. If, however, the course has applications to interdisciplinary programs across the colleges, then the course should be reviewed by the curriculum committee in the college in which the proposed course is generated, then it should be forwarded to the interdisciplinary committee, and that committee will forward the course proposal to the University Curriculum Committee.
