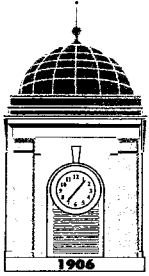

The University System of Georgia Council on General Education met in full session April 15, 2011. The Council did not approve your submission of PSYC 1200 for Area D.

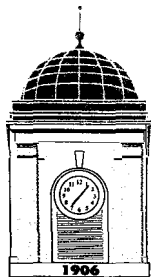
