- V. **GSCC**

Mr. Jahmal McCray reported that the GSCC last met October 30. One student was funded for a conference. The budget for spring funding requests is about \$9,000. The GSCC is working with Marketing to develop new branding. Some officers are graduating in December, so an election is being held to fill those

positions. November 27 will be the final meeting of year.

Ms. Megan Stachurski is working on the hooding ceremony. Time constraints will not allow for a ceremony for December graduates. The Fine Arts Auditorium has been reserved for a hooding ceremony for May 2013 graduates. The GSCC is now looking for some direction on what the next steps should be.

Dr. Carey Adams said that the hooding ceremony will take a joint commitment between the GSCC, the GAC, and the larger graduate body. This will not fall under the duties of the Commencement Committee. The Provost's Office is happy to assist with reservations, catering, and so forth, but management of the event must be a community effort.

## **VI. John Kraft**

### **A. Academic Dismissal Language, Revised (see Attachment 4)**

Dr. Kraft presented proposed language for the catalog, with a table that makes it clear how the timetable works for reapplication after academic dismissal. It shows clearly that summer term does count as a semester in this instance. The committee approved the language without discussion. The language will be published in the next graduate catalog.

### **B. Details on Students Academically Dismissed (see Attachment 5)**

Dr. Kraft went over a chart distributed earlier by email. It showed that very few of those dismissed reapplied. Of those who did reapply, most were accepted. Those who reapplied were usually dismissed for having two Cs. Those who had 2 Fs/WFs did not reapply. This accounts for about half of the students on the list.

### **C. Graduate Assistant Applications**

Everyone who submitted a program-designated GA request had their request approved. Thirteen of seventeen programs applied for a GA. The notification process is a little different this year due to personnel changes, but those letters should go out soon. There are four at-large slots. Applications for these slots are due by November 15. Six applications have been received so far. The ranking of unfunded applications will be preserved in case money should become available at a later date.

## **VII. Carey Adams**

### **A. Updated information on summer financials**

We did not make cut-off for revenue sharing, but the figure was closer to target than initially believed. Dr. Adams will be meeting with Mr. David Carson, Mr. Marc Mascolo, and Ms. Carol Cox to renegotiate the target for next summer. They have discussed the history of the \$1.9 million figure and have agreed that it needs to be revisited.

**VIII. Jill Bell**

Dr. Kraft reported on behalf of Ms. Bell. The posters for the Graduate Studies Open House have been modified (see Attachment 6). These will be distributed as soon as the button for the event is posted to the Armstrong home page. There will be some general dissemination of information from Graduate Studies, but the success of the event rests in large part on the program directors, deans, and department heads distributing information to specific populations they would like to target or think would be interested in coming.

**IX. Upcoming meeting dates**

There will be no meeting in December. The next meeting date will be January 8. Ms. Panhorst will set up subsequent meetings for the first Tuesday of the month, through April, and will send these dates by email once the room is confirmed.

### Academic Dismissal Due to Low Grades

Every student admitted to AASU with graduate student status must maintain a record of academic success in graduate coursework. A student may earn one C grade or below without being academically dismissed. If a student earns a second C or below the student will be dismissed regardless of overall GPA. After being academically dismissed, the student must wait one semester before reapplying for admission. Readmission is not guaranteed. [For the purposes of this policy, the summer session is considered a semester.](#)
