- IV. **Ad hoc committee on options for graduating seniors to take graduate level courses and at developing accelerated graduate programs.**

Following up on last month's recommendation from the Graduate Curriculum Committee and the formation of the ad hoc committee, Dr. Finlay reported that the committee had a meeting that included Dr. Patrice Mitchell, Mr. Marc Mascolo, Ms. Judy Ginter, Ms. Jill Bell, Ms. Lee Ann Kirkland, as well as committee members Dr. Patrick Thomas and Dr. Daniel Skidmore-Hess. Two things were discussed in terms of whether these things could be implemented and what it would take to do so:

- 1) Could graduating seniors be set up to take graduate classes, with the appropriate permission?

2) Assuming the first is possible, could graduate courses taken as an undergraduate be coded to count toward a graduate program as well, thus creating accelerated programs?

Dr. Finlay reported that while there are numerous technical issues, it would not be impossible to implement both items. He suggested that the next step should be to have more graduate faculty discuss whether we want to implement one or both of the items. He will arrange a meeting and report back at the March 5 meeting of the Graduate Affairs Committee.

**V. Approval of May Graduates (see Attachment 3)**

It was moved and seconded to accept the list of candidates for graduation as amended (noted on list with yellow highlight), provided they complete all degree requirements. The motion carried. Changes to the list from this point forward should be sent directly to Ms. Judy Ginter.

**VI. GSCC**

The hooding ceremony is 87 days away. The location has had to be changed due to the cost of making the Sports Center ADA compliant for the ceremony. The Student Union Ballroom has been selected as the new location. It seats approximately 450, which may mean putting a limit on the number of guests. The total number of graduating graduate students is 120. Please email Ms. Meagan Stachurski at ms4746@stu.armstrong.edu by the end of next week to let her know whether your program will participate or not. The date and time have not changed: Friday, May 3, 7:00-9:00 p.m. Ms. Stachurski looked into moving the ceremony to late afternoon, but there is a conflict with the ballroom for that time slot. Information on the hooding ceremony has been sent with the Registrar's email those graduating. The next email will go out on February 31. There will be a link to Survey Monkey for RSVPs. If any of the colleges have smaller banners that are not being used at commencement and could be used for the hooding, please let Ms. Stachurski know.

The GSCC is ordering a banner for Graduate Student Appreciation Week. The Tax and Relax event is being canceled due to low attendance. Instead, a dinner will be held instead during Graduate Student Appreciation Week.

Posters and table tents for the open house were delivered to offices by a work study student, but not everyone received them who was supposed to. If you did not receive any, please let Ms. Bell know. The poster was also sent by email PDF. If you would like for Ms. Bell to contact groups or individuals for you, please send her the information. After this event, it will be evaluated to see how effective the event has been in terms of recruitment and whether the event should be continued.
